Get rid of single-use plastics altogether.

Starting January 1st, 2023, the California Assembly Bill 1162 prohibits hotels with more than 50 rooms from providing guests with small single-use plastic bottles for shampoo, conditioners, lotions, and more. Hotels with less than 50 rooms have until January 2024 to comply. This could eventually apply to other states, so it is important to stay up to date.

IHG has been leading the hospitality trends and pledged to switch to sustainable bulk amenities by the end of 2022. By following this trend, you will not only be decreasing your carbon footprint, but you will be saving money on operation costs. Other properties and hotels are applying this solution to their own and are benefitting from this modern trend.

Marriott Hotels reported that switching to bulk would eliminate between 2 to 500 million plastic bottles yearly.

Marriott also discovered that the mini plastic bottles are too small to recycle and require the added expense to remove the residue liquids prior to recycling. However, bulk liquid bottles can be recycled.
